Title: World Outreach Committee Member

Ministry: World Outreach

Purpose of Ministry: To lead Valley in World Outreach prayer, giving and going so that the Great Commission is completed.

Purpose of Position: Serve with a group of about 15 others to lead Valley in World Outreach.

Serve on and possibly chair one of these subcommittees: Adult Community Mission Coordinators, Childrens Education, Communications, Executive and Finance, Local Outreach, Personnel, Prayer and Care, Short-term Missions, World Outreach Week.

Qualifications: World Outreach Committee members must meet the biblical qualifications of Deacon as set forth in I Timothy 3:8-13; and,

1. Active member of Valley Community Baptist Church.
2. Personal conviction that God's Great Commission (Mt. 28:19-20) flows out of a biblical approach to ministry by the local Church.
3. Recognition that cross-cultural ministry (Acts 1:8) is basic to church mission strategy.
4. Set and achieve goals with the subcommittee on which you serve.
5. Encourage involved people to take additional responsibilities in Valley's World Outreach ministry.
6. Recruit new people to specific tasks in World Outreach.
7. Evaluate missionaries and outreach opportunities.
8. Learn new trends and strategies for world evangelization.
9. Modify the existing approach to World Outreach so it consistently improves.

Key Working Relationships:

- Each committee member works under the authority of the World Outreach Committee chairperson.
- Each committee member works collaboratively and responsibly with the other members of this committee.
- The committee works closely with the Pastor of World Outreach on all matters impacting world outreach.

**Ministry
Responsibilities:**

1. Serve as a Prayer Partner for at least one Valley missionary.
2. Practice proportionate giving as taught in Malachi 3:8-11, 1 Corinthians 16:2, and 2 Corinthians 8:7,12 for Valley General Fun and World Outreach Faith Promise. Exactly what is done is strictly between you and God, but consider this a guiding principle.
3. Participate in World Outreach decisions: budget, candidate approval and mobilizing Valley attendees for world evangelization.
4. Regular review of a mission Web site (E.g.uscwm.org or urbana.org or a periodical (e.g. Mission Frontiers or Evangelical Missions Quarterly.)
5. Attend a missions training event annually.
6. Attend Perspectives on the World Christian Movement Course when it is offered locally. This occurs about every three years.
7. Participate in World Outreach Committee orientation that includes understanding the World Outreach strategy and policy.
